



## **The Adventure Camp at The Carey School For Current Pre-Kindergarten - 5th Grade Carey Siblings Welcome!**

### ***New!! The Adventure Camp at The Carey School!***

Welcome to the Adventure Camp at The Carey School! Weekly sessions at The Adventure Camp are filled with enrichment, where children enjoy innovative activities based on their personal interests. Large and small group activities will give each child a unique social experience. Children will have fun, exciting days where there is time to relax and to reflect. Parents, families, and friends are invited to watch their budding stars perform in a talent show that is held at the end of each session.

*Below is a sample day at The Adventure Camp:*

7:30am – 8:30am: Before camp care

8:30am -9:00am: Morning meeting, music and dance

9:00am – 10:30am: Science projects, sports and games, arts and crafts

10:30am – 11:00am: Snack and story telling

11:00am 12:00pm: Cooking projects, drama, out door play

12:00pm – 1:00pm: Lunch and board games

1:00pm – 2:30pm: Computer projects, sports and games, science projects

2:30pm – 4:00pm: Snack, talent-show preparation, video, closing meeting

4:00pm – 6:00pm: After camp care

*\*Under close supervision of our counselors, during one of our camp days, we will enjoy a neighborhood outing to Beresford Park (weather permitting).*

Each grade level has a schedule to ensure involvement in all activities. Twice a day children choose one or more activities in which to participate, including sports and games, arts and crafts, cooking projects, science projects, computer projects, and outdoor play. During our morning snack, we break for a quiet book time and story telling. Lunch is followed by a second set of activities. The day ends with snack, a video, and the closing meeting, where children share highlights of their day with the group.

**Children should bring packed lunch daily – there are no other provisions**
