The goal of this class is to have the children engage in various aspects of drama and production. The two areas we will focus on are drama skills and creative production. In Drama Skills we will practice the art of projecting the voice, improvisation, and stage use such as floor patterns. In Creative Production we will look in to stage design, working with and making props, costume creativity, and creating scripts.

At the end of the winter session we will provide a version of the production we're working on, which will compliment the 3<sup>rd</sup> ASA session and a final version of a full world premier play at the end of the Spring session!!!

### **Description**

It's time to play chess – one of the most popular games in the world! Girls and boys, beginners to experienced, are welcome to enroll in this fun class. Each session will begin with a chess lesson followed by exercises to improve understanding and skill. Students will have ample time to play chess with classmates each day. We also will have the opportunity to play each other on computers in the Computer Lab via our local network using special chess software! In addition, we can play against a 3D electronic chess set where the level of play is adjustable. Students will acquire a well-rounded exposure to traditional and modern chess play.

The course will begin with chess fundamentals so new students can learn to play and those with experience can acquire a deeper understanding. Topics covered will include a review of the rules, the value of chess pieces, how pieces move, how to open and attack, how to sacrifice a piece to gain the upper hand, how to checkmate, and how to form an overall winning strategy. Chess develops sharp problem-solving skills, analytical reasoning, patience – and it's fun to play!

Each session will begin with a study of chess as indicated below, with at least half of the period reserved so students to play each other or play chess on the computer.

Week 1 – Overview: Rules, pieces, values and movement

Week 2 – Chess review, notation & board layout (reading & writing chess moves)

Week 3 – Opening strategies & controlling the board

Week 4 – Attacking and defending pieces (double attack, pin, skewer)

Week 5 – Thinking ahead - when to sacrifice to gain control

Week 6 – How to play chess on the computer & 3D electronic chess set

Week 7 – Chess puzzles (1 to 3 moves to checkmate)

Week 8 – Chess play and review of strategies

Week 9 – Chess games and a mini tournament

Week 10 – Chess party and games
